## Religious Education at Weston Secondary School

## What is RE?

RE is the study of beliefs and how they impact believers. Throughout their time at Weston Secondary School, students will study a range of religious beliefs, including Christianity, Islam and Sikhism. They will investigate religious practices and investigate how religion influenced the lives of some inspirational people.

## What is included in an RE lesson?

Students will be taught about a range of beliefs, helping to understand the language of different faiths. Students in RE are most successful when they are able to articulate their own viewpoints around a range of issues and concepts. What do they think and why? Also having an interest in current/global affairs as well as an interest in exploring the beliefs and values of others and seeing how their views and values are similar and different to other people.

## What have Year 7 been looking at this Autumn term?

Students start the year by investigating the key question, 'What are beliefs and how do they impact believers?' This includes looking at stories from a range of cultures, investigating rites of passage from around the world and also looking at different types of celebration. Later in Year 7 students consider 'Who has the right belief about God?' and 'Is it always right to obey?'
